

Let's Combined the sentences

I started to live in Japan 2 years ago. I still live in Japan today.
= I have lived in Japan for 2 years

Present Perfect

(has / have) + (past participle)



I started to live in Japan in 2017. I still live in Japan today
= I have lived in Japan since 2017
