Model dialog A: winner , B: loser



A: Hello, OO. How are you today?

B: Hello, OO. I'm (fine / good / not bad), thank you.

A: What's your favorite place in Japan?

B: It's Okinawa.

A: (CS) How many times have you ever been there?

B: I have been there three times.

A: (CS) What did you do in Okinawa?

B: I went to Churaumi Aquarium.

A: (CS) How was it?

B: It was great!

A: (CS) I'm glad to hear that.

B: How about you? ※Change the roles

A/B: Nice talking with you.

A/B: Thank you, you too.



Conversation Strategies (CS) [examples]

☆Reactions: Uh-huh Really? That's interesting! No kidding! Nice!

☆Shadowing: I have been there three times. → Three times!

☆Opener/Closer: "Hello, how are you?" "Nice talking with you."

☆Follow-up questions: "What did you do there?" "How was it?"
